

RCCS 2011–2012 School Supply List Grades 8 – 12

These are the supplies your child will need to begin school. Teachers may request additional items.

MATH

<u>Pre-Algebra</u>	Pencils, calculator, hi-lighter
<u>Algebra 1</u>	<u>Non-scientific</u> calculator, graph paper, pencils, erasers, lined paper
<u>Algebra 2</u>	Scientific calculator, paper, pencils, graph paper
<u>Geometry</u>	Scientific calculator, paper, pencils, graph paper
<u>Advanced Math</u>	Scientific calculator and/or graphing calculator (TI- 82 or newer), paper, pencils

SOCIAL STUDIES

Geography, U.S. History, World History, Government

1-inch 3-ring binder (separate from other classes), white, college ruled, notebook paper, (not spiral edges!), colored pencils, pens (blue or black, red), dividers, 3x5 note cards, Kleenex, highlighters, Flash Drive, Access to the internet, MS Word, MS Powerpoint

SCIENCE

Scientific Calculator (non-graphing)

BIBLE
